Faith is critical to our relationship with God.

Without faith it is impossible to please Him. ^{KJV} **Hebrews 11:6**

^{Amp} **Hebrews 11:6** But **without faith** it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him.

Faith is a gift of God. **Romans 12:3**

^{NKJ} **John 10:10** "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that **they** may have life, and that **they** may have *it* **more abundantly**.
