

The Word of God will Open our Eyes!

Vision 2020 and Beyond, See Clearer, See Further and See Broader.

Open our eyes that we might see wonderous things in your law. *Psalm 119:18*

May the Word of God be the way we see naturally and spiritually. Lord, open our eyes to the vision you have preordained for us through your Word. Open our eyes that we might see wonders.

*Psalms 119:18* combines prayer and the Word as a pattern to model our lives to see the promises of God manifested in our daily lifestyle.

There are wonderful things in the Word of God.

The Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path. *Psalm 119:105*

Where there is no vision, the people perish, but he that keeps the law, happy is he. *Proverbs 29:18*

For the Word of God is living and powerful and sharper than any two-edge sword, piercing even to the division of the soul and spirit, and joints and marrow, and us a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. *Hebrews 4:12*

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. *2 Timothy 2:15*

The word law, in this verse is referring to instruction or teaching.

Seeing the word and knowing it and having it in us is crucial to living a life of holiness and love and power for the purposes of God.

The word is crucial to a life of holiness.

Only through God's supernatural help can we realize the power of God.

II

Prayer is the key to unlocking the power of the word in our lives. *Psalm 119* gives us examples how to pray.

That God would teach us His word – *Psalm 119:12*

That God would make us understand His word – *Psalm 119:27*

That God would incline our hearts to His word – *Psalm 119:36*

God would give us life to keep His word. *Psalm 119:88*

God would establish our steps in His word. *Psalm 119:133*

God would seek us when we go astray from His word. *Psalm 119:176*

III

Consider: *Luke 24:30-31*

And it came to pass, as He sat and met with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and broke, and gave to them. And their eyes were opened, and they knew Him; and He vanished out of their sight.

Communion with God will open our eyes.

The word open here is the Greek word di-anoigo, which means to open one's soul, to arouse understanding, awaken to obedience and arise to change.

God desires to open our eyes in the spiritual realm so that we will be able to understand and comprehend the will and purpose of God for our lives.

Open our eyes through the Word of God, to the truth of the risen Christ, to experience the supernatural power of God in our lives that we can see clearer, further and boarder in Jesus name, Amen
