

Prevailing in Prayer I

Vision can be sustained by prayer

All visions need to be bathed in prayer.

Prayer brings clarity to vision.

Consider *Daniel 10:1-4, 10-15*

I

Daniel's prayer was based on prophecy. Vs 1

Vision is sustained by prayer.

Vision is kept before us in prayer and reduces weariness.

We pray in a greement with the word of prophecy.

- Our agreement brings the word into the earth.
- Our agreement with the word brings it to pass.

II

Daniel's prayer was persistent.

Daniel gave himself to fasting and prayer. Vs 2-3

Daniel prayed 21 days.

The answer came on day 24. Vs 4

There is always warfare over the word. Vs 12-13

The first day we pray our prayer is heard. Vs 12

The answer comes from our words. Vs 12a

There is resistance to God's will in the earth. Vs 13

III

Daniel's prayer was productive. Vs 14

Daniel's prayer produced results.

Daniel's persistence brought divine help.

The result was a word of release, deliverance and return.

The vision was progressive.

Some components of the vision are for today.

Some components of the vision were for a future time.

- God speaks of the future like it is past.
- God's voice is future now!

The *isness* of God conveys He is presence, apparent presence and very present.

There is omnipresence, conspicuous presence and manifested presence.
