OVERVIEW OF PSALMS 7

SECOND PRAYER FOR JUDGMENT SHIGGAION (PRAISE) OF DAVID, WHICH HE SANG UNTO THE LORD, CONCERNING THE WORDS OF CUSH THE BENJAMITE.

SHIGGAION

THE MEANING OF SHIGGAION IS A SONG OF TROUBLE OR COMFORT AND AS WELL AS TO MEAN WANDER OR TO CRY ALOUD. KING DAVID WAS UNDER SOME STRONG MENTAL DISTRESS BY CUSH THE BENJAMITE... SHIGGAION IS ONLY USED HERE IN THE PSALMS (SEE HAB. 3:1) AND IS "A PASSIONATE PSALM WITH STRONG EMOTION".

"TEAR MY SOUL LIKE & LION": OFTEN THE PS&LMIST'S ENEMIES &RE SYMBOLIZED BY

VICIOUS, ATTACKING ANIMALS, WITH "THE KING OF BEASTS" OCCURRING FREQUENTLY (PSALMS 10:9; 17:12; 22:13, 16, 21).



PSALM 7:3 "O LORD MY GOD, IF I HAVE DONE THIS; IF THERE BE INIQUITY IN MY HANDS;"

PSALM 7:4 "IF I HAVE REWARDED EVIL UNTO HIM THAT WAS AT PEACE WITH ME; (YEA, I HAVE DELIVERED HIM THAT WITHOUT CAUSE IS MINE ENEMY:)"

PSALM 7:5 "LET THE ENEMY PERSECUTE MY SOUL, AND TAKE [IT]; YEA, LET HIM TREAD DOWN MY LIFE UPON THE EARTH, AND LAY MINE HONOR IN THE DUST. SELAH."

PSALM 7:6 "ARISE, O LORD, IN THINE ANGER, LIFT UP THYSELF BECAUSE OF THE RAGE OF MINE ENEMIES: AND AWAKE FOR ME [TO] THE JUDGMENT [THAT] THOU HAST COMMANDED."

PS&LM 7:7 "SO SHALL THE CONGREGATION OF THE PEOPLE COMPASS THEE &BOUT: FOR THEIR SAKES THEREFORE RETURN THOU ON HIGH."

PSALM 7:8 "THE LORD SHALL JUDGE THE PEOPLE: JUDGE ME, O LORD, ACCORDING TO MY RIGHTEOUSNESS, AND ACCORDING TO MINE INTEGRITY [THAT IS] IN ME."
