I

Exodus 1:15-22 And the king of Egypt spake to the **Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah:** ¹⁶ And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; if it be a son, then ye shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live. ¹⁷ **But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them,** but saved the men children alive. ¹⁸ And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have saved the men children alive? ¹⁹ And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women are not as the Egyptian women; for they are lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them. ²⁰ **Therefore God dealt well with the midwives: and the people multiplied, and waxed very mighty.** ²¹ **And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses.** ²² And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.

Shiphrah and Puah feared God more than the king and man.

We need women who will practice **justice** and refused to practice **infanticide**.

Infanticide is the killing of an infant.

The Lord showed favor to these women.

Never think your good goes **unnoticed** by God.

Exodus 2:1 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi. ² And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

Exodus 6:20 Amram took as his wife **Jochebed** his father's sister, and she bore him **Aaron and Moses**, the years of the life of Amram being 137 years.

NKJV **Exodus 2:5** Then **the daughter of Pharaoh** came down to bathe at the river. And her maidens walked along the riverside; and when she saw the ark among the reeds, she sent her maid to get it. ⁶ And when she opened it, she saw the child, and

behold, the baby wept. **So she had compassion on him, and said, “This is one of the Hebrews’ children.”**
