**Mt 24:45–47 (NLT)** -- <sup>45</sup> “A faithful, sensible servant is one to whom the master can give the **responsibility of managing his other household servants and feeding them.** <sup>46</sup> If the master returns and finds that the servant has done a good job, there will be a reward. <sup>47</sup> I tell you the truth, the master will put that servant in charge of all he owns.

- Strive to be a faithful, sensible servant:
- Strive to be one that God believes in, considers dependable, and trustworthy.
- Strive to be one who is filled with insight, understanding and wisdom.

**I) FAITHFUL SERVANTS ARE FAITHFUL MINISTERS**

A) We are ministers of his grace (1 Pet 4:10)

B) **2 Co 5:18–20 (NKJV)** -- <sup>18</sup> Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, <sup>19</sup> that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ’s behalf, be reconciled to God.

C) Creation is yearning for God’s Children (Rom 8:19).

**II) FAITHFUL SERVANTS STAY CONNECTED**

A) We are on assignment from heaven.

1) **Ge 2:5 (NLT)** -- <sup>5</sup> neither wild plants nor grains were growing on the earth. For the Lord God had not yet sent rain to water the earth, and there were no people to cultivate the soil.

B) Multicomplex times require people who can bring heaven to earth.

1) We are next up!

2) We are ministers of His grace (Rom 5:20)

3) We are our by nature a multidimensional church, our ecosystem includes the heavenly realm.

C) Faithful servants cultivate the earth so that it will release it’s produce.

D) Faithful servants reflect God’s will and purpose in the earth. (Eph 3:10-11).

**III) FAITHFUL SERVANTS MANAGE TROUBLE**

A) **1 Pe 4:10 (NKJV)** -- <sup>10</sup> As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

B) We are gifted to manage God’s house.

C) We manage trouble:

1) What we call a thing dictates our response to it.

2) God uses His people to demonstrate His authority over all realms.

3) Expectation is the greatest weapon against crisis.

D) Key to success is outlasting the season.

- 1) God uses faithful servants to demonstrate His authority over all realms and dimensions:
- 2) **1 Ki 20:28 (NLT)** -- <sup>28</sup> Then the man of God went to the king of Israel and said, "This is what the Lord says: The Arameans have said, 'The Lord is a god of the hills and not of the plains.' So I will defeat this vast army for you. Then you will know that I am the Lord."

#### **IV) Summary**

- A) We live in multi-complex world that demands a church that can operate in multicomplex dimensions.
- B) God anoints His people and sets them in place during specific times in order to simplify the complexity and integrate the dimensions.
- C) The key to this is being faithful, sensible servants who:
  - 1) Are faithful ministers
  - 2) Stay connected to God.
  - 3) Manage through trouble.
- D) God has fully equipped us to handle any trouble that we encounter.
- E) With His Help and by His power, it's our time now to work through the complexities and demonstrate authority in all dimensions.
