# SERVING HIM IN PARTNERSHIP

Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: <sup>2</sup> Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,<sup>3</sup> According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:<sup>4</sup> Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be **partakers** of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. **2 Peter 1:1-4 KJV** 

Peter states first that he is a servant and *secondly* mentions his calling as an apostle.

He boasts of being a servant just as *David* did in *Ps. 116:16*.

Peter understood to serve Christ with others of like faith was truly an honor.

God knows all things about us (consider Peter), yet He has still entrusted us to *Serve Him in Partnership*.

We are in this world to do work that glorifies God the Father just as God sent Jesus in the world to give us Salvation. Let's serve him in partnership!

## I. Like Faith for Stewardship

We are stewards in the Kingdom together and this like faith is of very great use, and *advantageous* to those who have it.

It is the same faith in Jesus that unites the weak <u>believer</u> to Christ just as it does the strong one, the impulsive and the prudent, the rough and the polished. the sanctified and not so sanctified. *Acts* 13:39

This same precious faith takes hold of the same *precious* Savior and manifests the same precious desire to serve in faith - *it's still a partnership*!

### II. Growth in the Knowledge of God

Peter is fulfilling the words of Jesus by encouraging those of like faith to grow in the knowledge of God which will <u>strengthen</u> them through grace and peace.

## Philippians 1:6

When we learn His ways, it positions us to be recipients of "everything pertaining to life and godliness."

### III. Partnership

We are *partners* with God, this is a divine connection between believers of like faith and God.
