God's Enabler - the Holy Spirit

A. The creation has been *damaged* & is *waiting* for the Sons of God to be *revealed*.

A-3. *Romans* 8(14-16). ¹⁴ For all who are <u>being led by the Spirit of God</u>, these are sons of God. ¹⁵ For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have <u>received a spirit</u> of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The <u>Spirit Himself testifies with our</u> spirit that we are children of God,

Romans 8:14-16 / NASB

A-4. *Romans* 8(19-22). ¹⁹ For the <u>anxious longing</u> of the <u>creation waits eagerly</u> for the <u>revealing</u> <u>of the sons of God</u>. ²⁰ For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope ²¹ that the <u>creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to</u> <u>corruption</u> into the <u>freedom of the glory of the children of God</u>. ²² For we know that the <u>whole</u> <u>creation groans and suffers</u> the pains of childbirth together until now. *Romans* 8:19-22 / *NASB*

God will reveal *His Glory* (gifts & knowledge) through *His Sons* to restore the creation.

B. The Sons are to be baptized with the *Holy Spirit*, not just water!

B-2. Acts 11(15-16).

C. The Sons will reveal the glory of God by the Holy Spirit through *Signs* (miracles)!

Mark 16 (15-18, 20). ¹⁵ And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the <u>gospel to all</u> <u>creation</u>. ¹⁶ "He who has <u>believed</u> and has been <u>baptized shall be saved</u>; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned. ¹⁷ "These <u>signs will accompany those who have believed</u>: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." *Mark 16:15-18 / NASB*

C-1. The Church is to be a *Prophetic Community* that is powerful in *word & works (signs)!*

In too many places, the Church views itself as a didactic (teaching, instructional) community than a prophetic community, where doctrine is treasured above charismatic action.

C-2. As a prophetic community, God's people are to be active in service.

In too many places, the Charismatic & Pentecost movements focus on the emotional experience. They emphasize the blessing more than they do Spirit-filled, Spirit-led, & Spirit-empowered service.

There has been a shift from vocation to personal experience, from world-centered to self-centered.

C-3. Acts 1(5-8) ⁵ for John baptized with water, <u>but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not</u> <u>many days from now</u>."⁶ So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?" ⁷ He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; ⁸ <u>but you will receive</u> <u>power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses</u> both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth." *Acts 1:5-8 | NASB*

We are Baptize with the Holy Spirit to receive power & to be *witnesses* (not necessarily Pastors). Vocation (primary occupation, life's work, calling, mission).

D. Below are other examples of the Holy Spirit's impact.

- D-1. Great rejoicing by Jesus Luke 10(21)
- D-2. Tongues speaking praise Acts 2(11)
- D-3. Purifying the Church with a word of knowledge. Ananias & Sapphire Acts 5(1-4)
- D-4. Impending famine is coming. Acts 11(27-28). Agabus
- D-5. Bonds of affliction awaiting Paul Acts 21(10)

The above highlight other effects of the Spirit beyond witnessing.

E. Luke is the only book in the New Testament to be written with a *sequel to the book of Acts (the spread of Christianity)*.

Luke-Acts is the longest book & the largest part of the New Testament.

F. Just as Jesus begins his ministry *anointed by the Holy Spirit*, so the disciples will not fulfill their ministry until they have been *baptized with the Holy Spirit*.

The pouring out of the Spirit of prophecy is neither the birth of the Church nor merely a blessing for God's people. Instead, it is vocational; that is, it baptizes & empowers a community of God's people to witness prophetically the arrival of the Messiah Jesus Christ & the new age which His arrival had inaugurated.

G. Deacons were *filled* with the *Holy Spirit* Steven. *Acts* 6(5&8). Phillip. *Acts* 8(5-7)

H. Speaking in tongues is an *objective reality*. It is a gift from the Holy Spirit, not a religious rite.

I. Prayer to *expand our view* of God. *Ephesians 1(18-19).*
