

The Presence of the Spirit of God I

The Spirit of God is over the waters, in the waters, beside the waters, and like water.

KJV Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. ² And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.**

God's presence is in the creation, and His presence is in chaos.

Psalm 77:12 I will meditate also of all thy work, and talk of thy doings. ¹³ Thy way, O God, is in the sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?

We experience God's acts, moves, and works in the sanctuary.

Psalm 77:19 Thy way is in the sea, and thy path in the great waters, and thy footsteps are not known. ²⁰ Thou leddest thy people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron.

We experience God's acts, moves, and works in the storms.

We learn why God acts, moves, and works in the silence of meditation.

KJV Psalm 103:7 He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.

Israel saw what God did.

Moses knew why He did it.

From His presence comes His voice.

I

John was fascinated with water, Chapters 1-7.

John was also fascinated with the feast.

NKJV **John 7:1** After these things Jesus walked in Galilee; for He did not want to walk in Judea, because the Jews sought to kill Him. ²
Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand.

Jesus was crucified on Passover.

Jesus poured out the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Jesus will come again at Tabernacles.

II

Jesus is the tabernacle of God with us.

KJV **John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Jesus is the presence of God among us.

Jesus is the presence of God as us.

KJV **Hebrews 9:24** For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, **now to appear in the presence of God for us:** ²⁵ Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; ²⁶ For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath **he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of**

himself. ²⁷ And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: ²⁸ So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look **for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.**

Jesus appeared Vs 27, He appears Vs 24, and He will appear again Vs 28!

KJV Revelation 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, **Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them,** and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

The presence of the Spirit of God is God with mankind.

III

Tabernacles is the season to recognize, respect, and respond to the presence of God.

His presence is with us, in us, through us, and as us.

In 2022, Rosh Hashanah will begin at sundown on **September 25th** and end at sundown on September 27th.

Yom Kippur 2022 will begin on the evening of **Tuesday, October 4** and ends in the evening of **Wednesday, October 5.**

Sukkot 2022 will begin in the evening of **Sunday, October 9** and ends in the evening of **Sunday, October 16.**

These seasons were demanded and commanded by the LORD.

NKJV Deuteronomy 16:16 "Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses: at

the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles; and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed. ¹⁷ Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God which He has given you. (Exodus 23:17)

These are proclaimed, **prophetic** and practical seasons of the LORD.

The last season is tabernacles, dwelling, abiding, habitation, presence!

NKJV Leviticus 23:42 You shall dwell in booths for seven days. All who are native Israelites shall **dwell in booths**, ⁴³ that your generations may know that **I made the children of Israel dwell in booths** when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.”

The presence of the Spirit is in the **temple** space.

The presence of the Spirit is in **sacred** space.

The presence of the Spirit is in the **community** space.

The presence of the Spirit is in the **marketplace**.

The presence of the Spirit is in **public** space.

The presence of the Spirit is in **domestic** space.

⇒ The presence of the Spirit is **everyplace**.
