#### Psalm 92

- Of all 150 Psalms, this is the only Psalm with this title...specifically to be song on the Sabbath
- A Song for the Sabbath Day...perhaps an indication that a day should be set aside for worship
- Speaks of the goodness of giving thanks to the Lord
- o Expresses the depth of God's works and purposes

#### **Composer:**

- o Specific writer not known; thought to be written by David
- King David was instrumental in bringing forth the beauty of musical instruments as a part of worship

#### I Chronicles 23:5

four thousand *were* gatekeepers, and four thousand praised the Lord with *musical* instruments, "which I made," *said David*, "for giving praise."

#### Psalm 92

Vs. 1-3: Believer's Duty to God 92 <sup>1</sup>It is good to give thanks to the Lord, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High;

Psalm 89:1 (Ethan)

I will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever;
With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness to all generations.

#### **Martin Luther**

".....come let us sing a song and drive away the devil." WHY is it good to give thanks to the Lord? Here are a few reasons:

Appropriate Right Does us good A benefit to us
 Sets an example Demonstration of our attitude
 Gives honor It's good manners Liberates us
 Encourages us A source of delight to worship the Lord

# <sup>2</sup> To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night,

- o In the morning we should long to wake up and sing to our God
- God's mercies and loving kindness are new every morning Lamentations 3: 22-23

Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not.<sup>23</sup> They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness

 In every evening we should want to declare His faithfulness because we are a witness of him seeing us through

# <sup>3</sup>On an instrument of ten strings, On the lute, And on the harp, With harmonious sound.

- o Thought of a united sound; spirit of unity
- Work of excellence in the sound we bring forth....harmonious
   Charles Spurgeon

It is said, Spurgeon did not have instruments in his church...he believed the greatest instruments were our voices.

# Vs. 4-5: Believer's Reasons to Praise God <sup>4</sup> For You, Lord, have made me glad through Your work; I will triumph in the works of Your hands.

- o You thrill me Lord, with all you have done for me
- o I will sing joyfully because of what you have done
- Focus is on God and not self; What God has done for us

### <sup>5</sup>O Lord, how great are Your works! Your thoughts are very deep.

- A declaration and adoration of God's works
- Praise unto God's works and wisdom
- What great works you do Lord
- How deep are your thoughts

#### **Psalm 40:5**

Many, O Lord my God, *are* Your wonderful works *Which* You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be recounted to You in order; *If* I would declare and speak *of them,* They are more than can be numbered.

# Vs. 6-9: Believer's Enemies Ignorance and End <sup>6</sup> A senseless man does not know, Nor does a fool understand this.

- Senseless man/fool has no common sense
- Old Testament writings the fool was considered a sinner
- o How foolish for us to think we can figure God out

# <sup>7</sup>When the wicked [a] spring up like grass, And when all the workers of iniquity flourish, *It is* that they may be destroyed forever.

 Wicked sprout like weeds, evil doers flourish but they will be destroyed forever.

#### Psalm 37:1-2

Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. <sup>2</sup>For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb.

### <sup>8</sup>But You, Lord, *are* on high forevermore.

o Most High God, Jehovah, will be exalted forever

# <sup>9</sup> For behold, Your enemies, O Lord, For behold, Your enemies shall perish; All the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.

- Your enemies Lord, shall surely perish and be scattered.
- o Evil, by its very nature is self-destructive

#### **Psalm 68:1**

Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered; Let those also who hate Him flee before Him.

#### Psalm 89:10

You have broken [a] Rahab (pride) in pieces, as one who is slain; You have scattered Your enemies with Your mighty arm.

- Wicked seem to prosper ...that they would be destroyed forever
- Thought: Favor of God towards man should not be judged by present prosperity
- o Enemies of the Lord will be destroyed

# Vs. 10-14: Believer's Blessings

# <sup>10</sup> But my <sup>[b]</sup>horn You have exalted like a wild ox; I have been anointed with fresh oil.

- o You have strengthened and anointed me with the finest oil
- o Horn symbolic of power, strength, victory

#### **Psalm 89:17**

For You *are* the glory of their strength, And in Your favor our [a]horn is exalted.

#### **Psalm 23:5**

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

# <sup>11</sup> My eye also has seen *my desire* on my enemies; My ears hear *my desire* on the wicked Who rise up against me.

- o My eyes have seen and my ears have heard the defeat of my enemies
- God allowed the righteous to see the manifestation of what they prayed for
- We pray and believe by faith, <u>spiritually</u> seeing the manifestation but not always seeing the manifestation in the <u>natural</u>...**keep praying and believing**

#### Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is the [a] substance of things hoped for, the [b] evidence of things not seen.

#### **Psalm 54:7**

For He has delivered me out of all trouble; And my eye has seen *its desire* upon my enemies.

- o God's blessing on His people:
  - Wicked destroyed
  - o Righteous strengthened
  - o Fresh anointing-God's grace
- To see the deliverance of God; to receive the deliverance of God is to have a fresh anointing

# <sup>12</sup> The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

- The writer declares this not just for himself but speaks of the community of believers...the righteous
- o Palm Tree:
  - Characteristic: Tall, Graceful, Beautiful and Erect; Storms of life come, it comes back stronger
  - Symbolic: Peace, Victory, Eternal Life
  - Usefulness: Fruit Bearing-Dates and Coconuts
- Cedar Tree:
  - Characteristic: Strong, Durable, Tall, Graceful, Fragrant, Resistant, Beautiful
  - o Symbolic: Protection, Wisdom, Strength
  - Usefulness: Does not shrink or Decay-Building and Preserving

# <sup>13</sup> Those who are planted in the house of the Lord

Planted-Stayed in God

### Shall flourish in the courts of our God.

Flourish-Fed by God

### <sup>14</sup> They shall still bear fruit in old age;

o Still Bear-Growing in God

# They shall be [c] fresh and [d] flourishing,

o Fresh-Able to do God's will

o In God's house, in the presence of the Lord is where we flourish and bear fruit in our old age; our body withers away but not our spirit

#### **Psalm 1:3**

He shall be like a tree Planted by the [a] rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

### Vs. 15: Believer's Purpose in Life

<sup>15</sup> To declare that the Lord is upright;

### He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

- o Vs. 15 gives another 'Why' for vs. 1
- o Declare our Lord is just, upright, our rock; there is no evil in Him

### **Psalm 92 Characteristics of a Fruit Bearing Believer in God:**

- Strength and Glory
- Satisfaction in life
- Confidence in God's faithfulness is our declaration

### Palm Tree Fact: The older the tree, the sweeter the fruit!
