

Psalm 93

The Majesty of the Lord

93 The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

² Thy throne is established of old: thou art from everlasting.

³ The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their waves.

⁴ The LORD on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea.

⁵ Thy testimonies are very sure: holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever.

Verse 1 – The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he had girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

- His Clothing
 - Majesty
 - Strength

Verse 2 – Thy throne is established of old: thou art from everlasting.

- God's Throne – Is Established
 - Eternal
 - Truth
 - Reign
 - Power

Verse 3 – The floods have lifted up, O Lord, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their waves.

- The Floods
 - Visual waves (see)
 - Voices –Sound (hear)
 - Strength (feel or experience)

- When the Floods come, God will be with us
 - Isaiah 59:19b
 - ¹⁹ So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.

Verse 4 – The LORD on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea.

- The Lord is ABOVE the Waves
 - On High
 - Mightier (more powerful)
- Jesus asleep (at peace) in the boat
 - Jesus Calms the Winds and the Sea
 - Matthew 8:23-24:
 - 23 And when he was entered into a ship, his disciples followed him.
 - 24 And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea, insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves: but he was asleep.
 - 25 And his disciples came to him, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish.
 - 26 And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.
 - 27 But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

Verse 5 – Thy testimonies are very sure: thy holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever.
