

Psalm 119 II

Psalm 119:49-96

Sections 7-12

There are 22 Sections in the Psalm. Each section begins with a Hebrew alphabet letter, 22 letters.

The psalm is largely a collection of prayers and meditations on the Word of God, referred to by 10 synonyms: the law, word, saying, commandments, statutes, judgments, precepts, testimony, ways, and path.

119:49-56 Steadying Words

Declare hope in ***troublesome*** times, for He will renew life (vs 50), strength, and expectations as you ***remember*** His judgment and ***keep*** His precepts.

119:57-64 With All My Heart

Live according to His word and ***continue*** your ***devotion*** when surrounded by your enemies.

119:65-72 Hard Lessons Learned

Hold to His statutes in affliction and ***learn commitment*** during times of trouble and slander. These lessons are more ***valuable*** than silver and gold.

119:73-80 Growth through the Word

Seek understanding in ***difficult*** times, not “I don’t understand?” but “give me understanding” according to your merciful kindness, that I live according to your word.

119:81-88 The Brink of Ruin

There are times when we are **mentally** and **physically** weak, fading and fainting because “they” seem to have the upper hand. Keep me alive and **revived** to give thy testimony.

119:89-96 The Great Certainties

His word is forever **settled** in heaven and through generations, giving hope, reviving life, and has no limits.
