Psalm 119:137-176 week 4

There are 22 Sections in the Psalm. Each section begins with a Hebrew alphabet letter, 22 letters.

The psalm is largely a collection of prayers and meditations on the Word of God, referred to by 10 synonyms: *the law, word, saying, commandments, statutes, judgments, precepts, testimony, ways, and path.*

Sections 18-22

Psalm 119:137-144 Everlasting Righteousness

The psalmist declared that because the Lord is righteous, His Word is righteous, and he found c*omfort* in God's righteous laws when he was in a*ffliction*.

Psalm 119:145-152 His word is true

The psalmist called on the Lord to deliver him because he o**beyed**, h**oped** in, and m**editated** on His Word, and God was also near him, and His words were reliable.

Psalm 119:153-160 Precious Life and Love of God's Word

The psalmist called on God to d<u>eliver</u> him because he had not forgotten His Law and loved God's Word, which is true, and therefore he asked to be p<u>reserved</u> from his enemies.

Psalm 119:161-168 The Place of Peace and Rejoicing in God's Word

The psalmist affirmed that though princes hated him without a cause, he t<u>rembled</u> in awe at God's Word and said he had o<u>bserved</u> the Law out of love for it.

Psalm 119:169-176 The reward and deliverance of the Word

The psalmist called on God to hear his supplication and d*eliver* him, though c*onfessing* that he had gone astray like a lost sheep, he is asking God to r*escue* him by His Word.
