\*\*For Hebrews 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by **the word of God**, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

In Genesis 1 and 2, "God said, God called, and then God saw."

Nothing that exists came into being until God said it.

Man was *created* in the image of God.

Man was created in the likeness of God.

We recognize the *Imago Dei*, the image of God in every human being. *Genesis* 1:26-28

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. <sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. <sup>28</sup> And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

The i*mage* (selem) of God is His nature.

Man is lesser than and finite in his r*eflection* of the nature of God.

His n*ature* includes His life, personality, truth, wisdom, love, holiness, and justice.

As image bearers, we have the capacity for spiritual fellowship with Him.

We are created in His likeness means, we are created to function, behave, and act like Him.

The habits and actions of Christ are *Habitus Christus*.

Adam was created entirely and as one being.

KJV Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; <sup>2</sup> Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

Mankind's words carry power in the Earth and in the heaven like his creator.

Death and life are in the p*ower* of the tongue.

<sup>KJV</sup> **Proverbs 18:20** A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. <sup>21</sup> **Death and life** are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

**Proverbs 18:20 Wise words** satisfy like a good meal; **the right words** bring satisfaction. <sup>21</sup> **The tongue** can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.

*Matthew* **12:37** For **by thy words** thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Our words will be a portion of our eternal judgment in the end.

James teaches us to control our tongues.

of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind: <sup>8</sup> But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. <sup>9</sup> Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, fwhich are made after the similitude of God. <sup>10</sup> Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

The tongue controls and defiles the whole body. **Vs. 6** 

The tongue can be an unruly evil voice. **Vs 8** 

The tongue can also be a source of blessing and increase. **Vs 10**
