“Connecting to different people”

Much of the Bible is written about strangers.

Strangers were internationals, foreigners, and migrants, people moving from place to place.

Migrants in the time of the Bible, internationals, foreigners, and strangers were often abused and mistreated.

KJV John 1:11-13 He came unto his own, and his own received him not. ¹² But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: ¹³ Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

I

We must connect with the head.

John 3

“We know you are a man, come from God.” Vs 2

Nicodemus came to Jesus.

Who is the Lord sending to you?

II

We must Connect through the heart.

John 4

“I must go through Samaria” Vs 4

To connect, we must connect our heads to our hearts.

We must connect our thoughts about people and our passion for people.

Who is God sending you to?

III

We must connect to the habits.

John 5

Jesus attended the feast of Passover regularly.

To connect, we must connect our hearts with our habits.

Habits or activities we do regularly.

Habits can open doors for new connections.

Who are the new people you can connect with during your regular activities?

IV

We must connect our hands.

John 6

“And **Jesus took** the loaves; and when he had given thanks, **he distributed to the disciples**, and the **disciples to them that were set down**; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.” *Vs 11*

To connect, we must connect habits with hands.

Faith without works is dead.

What work is God connecting you to?

What people is the Lord connecting you to work with?

V

We must connect with the Holy Spirit, to connect to people.

John 7

³⁸ “He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. ³⁹ (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)” **Vs 38-39**

Who is the Holy Ghost connecting you to?

Faith connects the head, heart, habit, hands, and the Holy Spirit.

KJV **John 9:4** I must work the works of Him who sent me while it's day. The night comes when no man can work!

NLT **John 9:4** We must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the one who sent us. The night is coming, and then no one can work.

“Let's work energetically, urgently, and decisively to connect with people.”
