Honoring Faithful Men

Proverbs 20:6 (NKJV)

*Most men will proclaim each his own goodness,
But who can find a faithful man?*

The word faithful describes a person who is consistently reliable.

The word faithful describes a person who demonstrates unwavering commitment to someone or something.

The word faithful describes a person who is steadfast, dedicated, dependable, and trustworthy.

I. Being faithful to God

Faithful men remain in alignment with God in the midst of societal pressure.

Joshua 24:15 (NLT) says, “*But if you refuse to serve the Lord, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord.*”

Faithful men put their trust in God when times get hard.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT) says, “*Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.*”

Faithful men are doers of the Word of God.

James 1:22 (GNT) says, “*Do not deceive yourselves by just listening to his word; instead, put it into practice.*”

II. Being Faithful to Our Wives

Faithful men love their wives.



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Ephesians 5:25 (NLT) says, *“For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her”*

Faithful men provide for their wife and children.

1 Timothy 5:8 (NIV) says, *“Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.”*

Faithful men understand that the way they treat their wife is likely to be the model our sons and daughters follow.

1 Corinthians 11:1-2 (NLT) says, *“And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ. ²I am so glad that you always keep me in your thoughts, and that you are following the teachings I passed on to you.”*

III. Being faithful to our children

Faithful men provide a spiritual foundation for their children.

Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV) says, *“Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.”*

Faithful men don’t give up on their children when they make mistakes in their life.

Consider Luke 15:11-32

Faithful men leave a legacy.

Proverbs 13:22a (NKJV) says, *“A good man leaves an inheritance to his children’s children...”*
